



#### **EASTER: LUKE 24:1-7**

On the first day of the week, at early dawn, [the women] came to the tomb, taking the spices that they had prepared. <sup>2</sup>They found the stone rolled away from the tomb, <sup>3</sup>but when they went in, they did not find the body. <sup>4</sup>While they were perplexed about this, suddenly two men in dazzling clothes stood beside them. <sup>5</sup>The women were terrified and bowed their faces to the ground, but the men said to them, "Why do you look for the living among the dead? He is not here, but has risen. <sup>6</sup>Remember how he told you, while he was still in Galilee, <sup>7</sup>that the Son of Man must be handed over to sinners, and be crucified, and on the third day rise again."

 When was a time when something unexpected happened to you? Why do you seek the living among the dead?


Risen Christ, we are thankful that you rose from the dead to give us eternal life. Help us to live as your people of hope, both now and always. Amen.

#### **THOMAS: JOHN 20:26-29**

A week later his disciples were again in the house, and Thomas was with them. Although the doors were shut, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you." <sup>27</sup>Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here and see my hands. Reach out your hand and put it in my side. Do not doubt but believe." <sup>28</sup>Thomas answered him, "My Lord and my God!" <sup>29</sup>Jesus said to him, "Have you believed because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have come to believe."

 What is something that you had to see in order to believe? What/who do you believe, even if you have never seen it for yourself? Why do you think Jesus says "Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have come to believe"?

Risen Christ, we are thankful that you appeared to Thomas, and helped him to believe in you. Help us to believe in the great miracle of Easter, and to share it with those who need to hear it. Amen.



## FISHING: JOHN 21:4-7a

Just after daybreak, Jesus stood on the beach; but the disciples did not know that it was Jesus. <sup>5</sup>Jesus said to them, "Children, you have no fish, have you?" They answered him, "No." <sup>6</sup>He said to them, "Cast the net to the right side of the boat, and you will find some." So they cast it, and now they were not able to haul it in because there were so many fish. <sup>7</sup>That disciple whom Jesus loved said to Peter, "It is the Lord!"

• Why do you think that Peter decides to go fishing? Why do you think that Jesus provided so many fish? Tell about a time when you had an amazing breakfast. What made it memorable?

Risen Christ, we thank you for appearing to the disciples after Easter. Help us to know that you are with us, and that you care for us. In Jesus' name we pray, Amen.

#### GOOD SHEPHERD: JOHN 10:25-30

<sup>25</sup>Jesus answered, "I have told you, and you do not believe. The works that I do in my Father's name testify to me; <sup>26</sup>but you do not believe, because you do not belong to my sheep. <sup>27</sup>My sheep hear my voice. I know them, and they follow me. <sup>28</sup>I give them eternal life, and they will never perish. No one will snatch them out of my hand. <sup>29</sup>What my Father has given me is greater than all else, and no one can snatch it out of the Father's hand. <sup>30</sup>The Father and I are one."

• What are some ways that you listen for God? What does it mean to you to know that no one can snatch you out of God's hands?


Risen Christ, thank you for making us your sheep. Open our ears to hear your voice, that we may learn to follow you. In Jesus' name we pray, Amen.

#### LOVE: JOHN 13:31-35

When he had gone out, Jesus said, "Now the Son of Man has been glorified, and God has been glorified in him. <sup>32</sup>If God has been glorified in him, God will also glorify him in himself and will glorify him at once. <sup>33</sup>Little children, I am with you only a little longer. You will look for me; and as I said to the Jews so now I say to you, 'Where I am going, you cannot come.' <sup>34</sup>I give you a new commandment, that you love one another. Just as I have loved you, you also should love one another. <sup>35</sup>By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."

• What are some ways that God shows love for you? What are some ways that others show you they love you? How do you show your love for others?

Risen Christ, thank you for loving us enough to go to the cross for us. Help us to obey your commandment, to love another as you first loved us. In Jesus' name we pray, Amen.



## HOME: JOHN 14:23-26

Jesus answered [Judas (not Iscariot),] "Those who love me will keep my word, and my Father will love them, and we will come to them and make our home with them. <sup>24</sup>Whoever does not love me does not keep my words; and the word that you hear is not mine, but is from the Father who sent me

<sup>25</sup>"I have said these things to you while I am still with you. <sup>26</sup>But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything, and remind you of all that I have said to you.

 Where is the place that you call home? What difference does it make to know that God is at home with you there, as well? What do you think of the Holy Spirit? Where does the Spirit show up in your life?

Risen Christ, thank you for making your home with, and for sending your Holy Spirit to teach us and remind us of your presence. Fill us with your abiding love. In Jesus' name we pray, Amen.

#### **ASCENSION: ACTS 1:8-11**

[Jesus said] "You will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." <sup>9</sup>When he had said this, as they were watching, he was lifted up, and a cloud took him out of their sight. <sup>10</sup>While he was going and they were gazing up toward heaven, suddenly two men in white robes stood by them. <sup>11</sup>They said, "Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking up toward heaven? This Jesus, who has been taken up from you into heaven, will come in the same way as you saw him go into heaven."

 Why do you think that Jesus ascends to heaven, instead of staying on earth? Why send the Holy Spirit? What are you looking forward to?

Risen Christ, thank you for making a place for us in heaven. Send your Holy Spirit among us, that we may be your risen people. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.

### PENTECOST: ACTS 2:1-4

When the day of Pentecost had come, [the apostles] were all together in one place. <sup>2</sup>And suddenly from heaven there came a sound like the rush of a violent wind, and it filled the entire house where they were sitting. <sup>3</sup>Divided tongues, as of fire, appeared among them, and a tongue rested on each of them. <sup>4</sup>All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other languages, as the Spirit gave them ability.

 Why do you think that the Holy Spirit comes in wind, fire, and language? How do you experience the Holy Spirit? What is the Spirit stirring up in you?

Holy Spirit, Breath of Life, breathe the fire of your love into us. Shape us, give us life, make us whole. Help us to spread the love of Christ to the ends of the earth. In Jesus' name we pray, Amen.
